

Diving Safari Montenegro

Montenegro, Paradise Lost. The small, scenic country between Croatia and Albania does not only merit a trip because of its mountainous coast. There is also something to discover under water: numerous wrecks and mysterious caves in jagged rock walls. Look forward to an extraordinary diving holiday and explore with us the wild beauty of Montenegro!

Saturday

Arrival, going aboard

Sunday

Cast off! There we go to our first diving goal (2), the wreck of the patrol boat „PBR 512“. The ship sank in 1983 by a torpedo hit. One can dive through the big shot hole.

Let's go further to the „TIHANI“, a former steamer (3). Due to a navigation error, the ship sank in 1917 and since then it lies on the 40 meters deep, sandy ground in the vicinity of the Mamula Island.

During the night we anchor, depending on the weather conditions, in the authentic Bay of Dobrec (4) or in front of Zanic.

Monday

After a copious breakfast we hoist anchor and explore the steep rugged southern coast of Lustica. Impressive names as Blue Cave (5), Mermaid Hole (6) or Poseidon City (7) adumbrate the charm of these spots and don't promise too much.

After having explored all caves, we drop anchor in the picturesque fishermen's village of Bigovo (8), where we will spend the night.

Tuesday

Today we set course to the „ORESTE“ (9). The almost 2700 GRT big Italian freighter ran onto a mine in March 1942 and broke into two parts. It lies on sandy ground at a depth of 30 meters.

Continuing our journey to Jaz (10) we make another stop at the „Galiola“ reef (11). Two vertical tunnels signalize this spot.

Wednesday

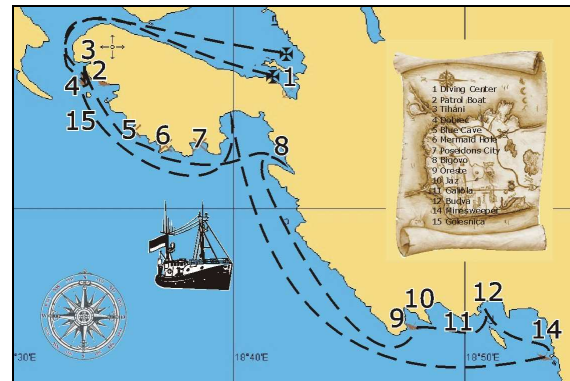
The Wednesday is characterized by recreation and relaxation, without diving.

After an extensive bath at the beach of Jaz (10), we go to Budva (12). Apart from the historical old center, the town strikes first of all by the long beach promenade with its numerous bars.

Thursday

As experience teaches, we slow down a bit in the morning after our visit to Budva. We set course to the most southern point of our trip, Sveti Stefan. Here lies a sunken minesweeper (14) at a depth of around 30 meters under the water level.

As the whim takes us and depending on the weather conditions, we spend the night once more in Budva, Jaz or Trsteno.



You can participate in an excursion to the historical old town of Kotor, a UNESCO World Heritage site.

Friday

We hoist anchor in due time, as today we go back. At the wreck of the torpedo boat „T1 GOLESNICA“ (15) we make an interim stop. The boat built in 1913 was sunken in 1959 and lies on sandy ground at a depth of 35 meters.

Arrived at our mooring (1) we can recapitulate our experiences once more and let fade away the vacation, enjoying fresh mussels, home-made wine and rakia.

Saturday
